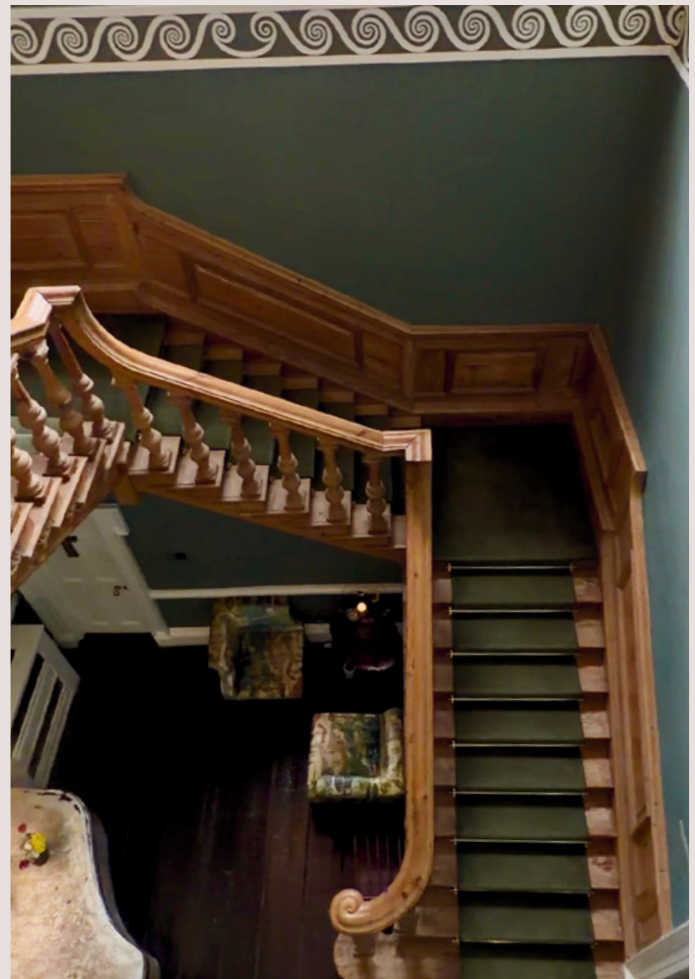

The Bridal Suite

Get ready for your magical 'I do' in a magnificent Georgian manor, graced by sweeping lawns and centuries-old trees. Bellinter House's estate is more than a venue; it is a timeless work of art.

Located on the first floor of the Main House, our Bridal Suite was once George Briscoe's bedroom and overlooks the front lawn. If walls could talk, we're sure this room could tell plenty of stories from Bellinter's past - including how George Briscoe carved his initials into the fireplace in 1884.



The Schoolhouse

A beautifully secluded, two-bedroom retreat set apart from the Main House, The Schoolhouse features two spacious deluxe double en-suite bedrooms, a shared dressing room, and a private outdoor hot tub overlooking the front lawn.

It is the perfect bright and welcoming setting for pre-wedding preparations.

The historic Schoolhouse was once an education centre operated by the Sisters of Sion for local children. Did you know that the Sisters of Sion purchased Bellinter House in 1965?

For decades, the French religious order operated the estate as an educational and retreat centre. The Sisters also lovingly restored the house to its former glory and planted many of the beautiful gardens that guests can enjoy to this day.

The Dalai Lama once visited the Sisters at Bellinter.



Weeping Beech Tree

Located on the front lawn opposite the Main House, our 150-year-old weeping beech tree provides a magical setting for outdoor ceremonies. Its sweeping branches cascade to the ground before curving upwards again, creating a natural, fairytale-like sanctuary - a hidden room filled with twinkling lights that you can step inside.

In Ireland, beech trees are traditionally associated with ancient wisdom, written knowledge and the nurturing, feminine energy of the woodland.



The Nunnery

Located in the 18th-century East Wing of Bellinter House, The Nunnery is an elegant and intimate setting for unforgettable wedding ceremonies.

Steeped in history and rich with character, this exquisite space features vaulted ceilings, arched details, and striking ornate stone pillars, beautifully complemented by modern comforts and thoughtful design.

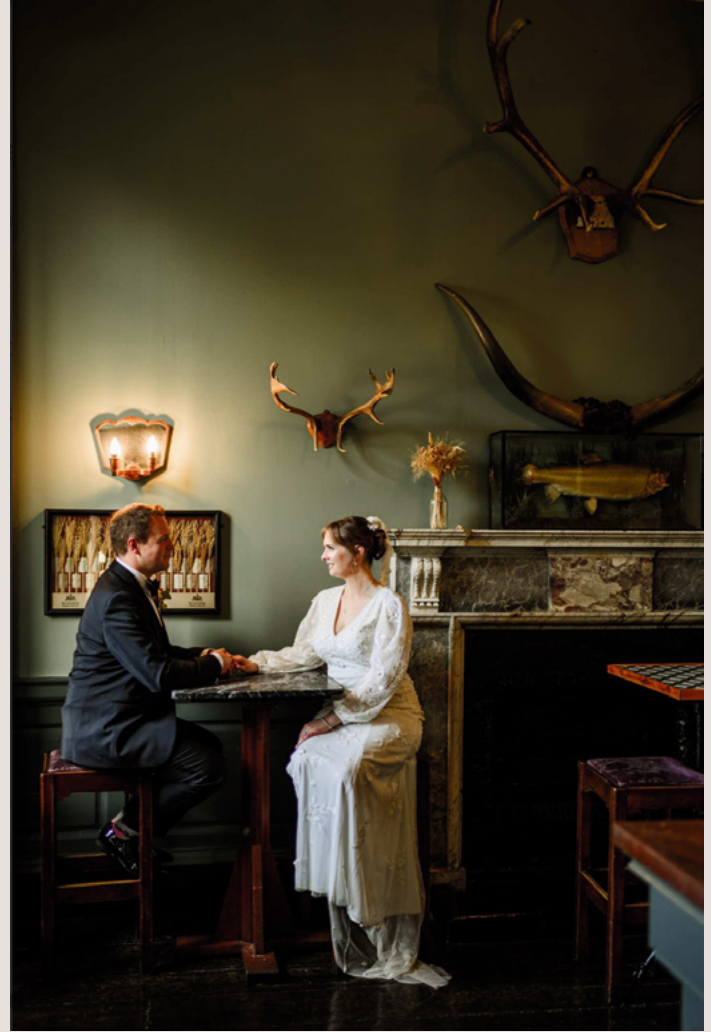
Perfect for civil ceremonies, humanist ceremonies and blessings, The Nunnery offers a sophisticated and atmospheric backdrop for saying "I do."
